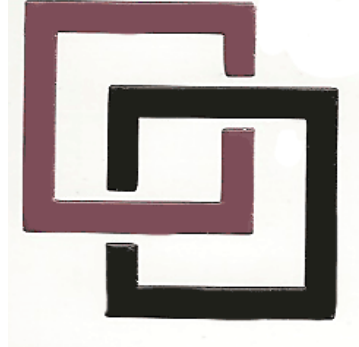

Because this is a fast moving class, not all Advanced dancers may be ready for it. The first two nights will feature high-level Advanced dancing while introducing some C1 calls and concepts. Students are expected to study the definitions of calls to be taught each week. Other study materials will also be recommended during the class.
